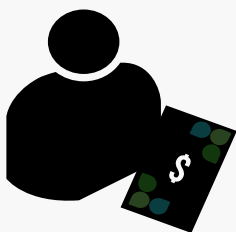

\$4 MILLION donated to community groups, charities and non-profit organizations by Alberta credit unions.

6,600 HOURS volunteered in the community by credit union employees.

\$85,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS were given to high school and post-secondary students to support their education goals.

37% of Alberta credit union executives and board members are female as of June 2023.

1,300 MEMBERS of the Sunchild First Nation supported through truth and reconciliation activities and initiatives.

8 Alberta credit unions offer community-focused financial literacy programs and initiatives.

Lending

\$13.8 BILLION in residential loans (+3.8% year-over-year).

\$9.17 BILLION in credit union commercial lending (+11.6% year-over-year).

\$1.76 BILLION in lending to support Alberta's agriculture and agri-food industry (+14.7% year-over-year).
